- -Weekly Inclusion in all classes of a level 3/4 activity based on the DOK as evidenced by weekly CFIP meetings, with a focus on reflecting on the performance of African American students on weekly rigorous tasks via both CFIP and CSST.
- -70% of African American students will meet growth targets in Read/Math, 60% will score 3 or higher on PARCC
- -Increase engagement grand mean by .2 students and .1 staff (Gallup)

KEY ACTION STEPS

RIGOR ACTION STEPS:

- Incorporate DOK Levels 3 and/or 4 at least biweekly
- Align SLO's with rigorous targets and DOK 3 or 4 assessments, with at least 85% full attainment
- Include county defined elements of rigor in both reading and math

PERFORMANCE ACTION STEPS:

- Monthly SIT to Review Data/Strategies
- Revised CFIP to include bi-weekly CSST student data reviews
- Individual Committees to Address DOK, Weekly Students of Success meetings through BSAP and Quarterly Parent Academies through BSAP

STUDENT ENGAGEMENT ACTION STEPS:

- -School Spirit Committee established within PBIS
- Quarterly Recognition for Academic Achievement
- -Monthly Students of the Month from all Grade Levels/Teams
