



#### **COVID-19 response**

- All students are eligible for free breakfast
- Arrival, locker time, and transition to period 1 is between 7:24-7:34 AM
- All students must be in Period 1 by 7:34 AM
- Breakfast in classrooms between 7:34-7:44 AM
- Period 1 begins at 7:45 AM

#### Lunch

- Enter cafeteria, sit, and wait for instructions
- Outdoor eating is available
- Staff will review procedures throughout the first week of school
- Seating is open- sit where you prefer
- Free lunch waivers expired on June 30 and we will return to pre-pandemic ways of providing meals to students based on eligibility (free, reduced-price, and paid). We encourage households to complete <u>Free and Reduced</u> <u>Meal</u> applications, based on your household income eligibility.

**Policy 8080 -** Responsible Use of Technology, Digital Tools, and Social Media

HCPSS permits students to bring personal technology devices to school, according to the following rules:

Middle Schools – Students:

 Students will not use personal technology devices during non-instructional time, to include but not limited to transition between classes, lunch, recess, or in bathrooms.
